SONG LEADER

Music plays a big part in making the large-group segment of Awana exciting and memorable for kids. If God has gifted you musically and you enjoy working with children, the role of song leader may be just where you belong!

Selecting the Right Music

The main responsibility of song leaders is to team up with the Awana commander or club directors and select the right music that matches each week's theme and purpose. As weekly direction is set, song leaders offer music choices that creatively engage children during the song portion of Large Group Time.

Leading Kids in Worship
